28th Annual Crisnée flea market organized by the St. Dominic school

We welcome you on the site of our annual flea market. Please find hereunder the internal regulations of our flea market which we invite you to apply so that it takes place in the best conditions. All exhibitors are required to have read and accepted these conditions.

- ✓ The installation of the flea market starts at **midnight**.
- ✓ **All traffic will be prohibited from 6 a.m. to 18 p.m.**

The sale of new items, drinks and food is prohibited without prior agreement with the organizers. Only professional or private individual second-hand dealers will be admitted (no merchants or other non-profit-making organization are allowed). Violators will be immediately excluded from the event.

- ✓ **Professional or private individual second-hand dealers need no prior booking! The organizers will designate the location of each participant!**
- ✓ The numbered and outlined locations on the floor are **exclusively** reserved to the organizer.

- ✓ The vehicles must be part of the sales location or be parked outside the flea market.
- ✓ Respect the traffic directions, the indications of the site commissioners and never perform a U-turn on the circuit of the flea market. These instructions will stay in use until the late afternoon.
- ✓ A participation fee will be requested for the occupation of your site (13 Euros for 5 m and 2.5 Euros per additional meter).
- ✓ Our flea market is organized in agreement with the municipality of Crisnée.
- ✓ **The "friendly cooperation" with the residents will always be privileged. Out of respect, the waste must be taken away at the end of the market.**
- ✓ The organisers are not responsible for accidents and possible damages.
- ✓ **The organizing committee reserves the right to deny access and to exclude any exhibitor who fails to comply with these conditions.**

ON POLICE ORDER and for safety reasons, a corridor of **3 m** must remain free in the middle of the road to make way for emergency vehicles. A test will be conducted with the assistance of a civil defence vehicle!
