Flea Market Rules

Dear friends, we are welcoming you in our annual Crisnée Flea Market, organized by the School Saint-Dominique. Please find hereafter the few rules which we invite you to respect so that our flea market takes place in the best possible conditions.

By participating to our flea market, every participant is accepting to comply with the following rules:

- The installation of the flea market and the booths is starting as of midnight,
- All car/van traffic will be prohibited from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- The sale of new items, as well as the sale of drinks and food is prohibited without prior agreement with the organizers. Only private participants or second-hand professionals will be admitted (merchants or other non-profit-making are not allowed). Violators will be immediately excluded from the event.
- There is no booth reservation possible, neither for private nor for professional participants. The organizers will designate the location of each participant upon arrival.
- The numbered and reserved locations painted on the floor are exclusively reserved for the organizers.
- The vehicles are considered as part of the booth, if not parked outside the flea market.
- Everyone must respect the « one-way » traffic directions and the indications given by the organizers. U-turns are not allowed on the circuit of the flea market. These instructions will remain applicable until flea market closure.
- A participation fee is due for the occupation of each booth: 15 EUR for 5 meters and 3 EUR per additional meter.
- Our flea market is organized in agreement with the municipality of Crisnée.
- A "friendly cooperation" with the residents needs to be respected and always be privileged. Out of respect, any waste must be taken away by yourself at the end of the market.
- The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any accident or any possible damage.

By Police order, and for safety reasons, a corridor of 3 meters must remain free in the middle of the road to make way for emergency vehicles. A test will be conducted a vehicle of the Civil Security.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to deny access and to exclude any exhibitor who fails to comply with these rules.
